Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.31 dated 17.05.2018 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

Reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Nabha, District Patiala is already on record.

A separate affidavit of respondent No.4, filed in the Court today is taken on record.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Karambir Singh has argued that the cancellation report dated 17.05.2018 was submitted before the trial Court, however, the same was not accepted by the trial Court and was sent back.

In the affidavit of respondent No.4 – Balkar Singh, it is stated that the petitioner Kuldeep Kaur had no role in the death of her husband namely Avtar Singh, brother of the complainant and the

deponent has no objection if the FIR is quashed.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of and the Investigating Officer is directed to submit the cancellation report before the Illaqa Magistrate within a period of 02 weeks from today. The Illaqa Magistrate after giving notice to the complainant – Balkar Singh and recording his statement will pass an appropriate order within a period of 01 month thereafter.

Disposed of accordingly.
