Learned State counsel has very fairly stated that the claim of the petitioner as regards counting of his daily wage service prior to regularization towards qualifying service and consequently for him to be governed by the Old G.P.F Scheme is covered in his favour in terms of a Division Bench judgement of this Court in ***CWP-2371-2010 (Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab and others)*** decided on 31.8.2010.

She prays for a short accommodation to verify the service record of the petitioner and to pass a final order as regards his claim.

The prayer is found to be just and reasonable.

Let a final order on the claim of the petitioner be passed within a period of four weeks from today and be communicated to him.

No further directions are required to be passed.

Petition is disposed of.
