The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.602, dated 15.12.2015, registered under Sections 148/149/323/307/341/285 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

2. The Petitioner was originally on bail. He, however, absented from the proceedings in the Ld. Court below on 28.01.2019 after which his Bail Bonds were cancelled.

3. Petitioner's submission in this regard is that he could not appear before the Ld. Court below on the relevant date on account of his illness.

4. He was nevertheless arrested in connection with a separate case FIR No.126 dated 15.05.2019 and was thereafter produced before the Ld. Trial Court subsequently on 11.09.2019 on the strength of a Production Warrant.

5. The Petitioner, therefore, now seeks his release on fresh bail.

6. In the given circumstances, considering the long detention undergone by the Petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant him the relief of bail at this stage, since admittedly investigation is complete long ago and the trial is likely to take its own time, as even till now evidence from the prosecution side has not yet commenced. As such, the Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
