In compliance of the order dated 13.11.2019 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Anshraj Singh, IAS, District Magistrate, Sonipat has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record.

As per para No.4 of the aforesaid affidavit, no detenue was found at the site at the time of inquiry. Statements of labourers namely Brijpal, Parveen, Balraj, Mukesh, Rajesh and Dharamvir were recorded. It was found that the petitioner neither came on the brick kiln, nor done any work there. Brick kiln was closed by the Government. The inspection of the Brick kiln was also done.

Mr. Jitender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Head Quarter, Sonipat has also filed his affidavit to the same effect endorsing that during inquiry, owner of the said Brick kiln was associated. As per his statement, the alleged detainee never came to his Brick kiln for any labour work. The persons found at the spot also confirmed the aforesaid position.

In view of aforesaid attending circumstances, no interference is called for. This petition is accordingly dismissed.
