The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.81 dated 15.10.2019 under Section 354 IPC (later on made into Section 354-B IPC) registered at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 15.11.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Angrej Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 15.11.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
