Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.387 dated 24.06.2019, registered at Police Station Sector 29, Gurugram, under Sections 379-B, 201 and 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. He has not committed any offence.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, submits that the petitioner was earlier driver of the vehicle used for carrying cash of different banks and on the information given by him, the other accused has committed the crime. The petitioner has been named on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused, Ramji @ Malinga.

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I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

There are allegation against the petitioner that he had supplied information to the co-accused for committing the offence. Some amount of booty has also been recovered from him.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find any ground to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
