This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking for quashing of FIR No. 55 dated 26.4.2019 (Annexure P/1) registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 323 IPC at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties and the averments made in the petition, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate court to get their statement recorded regarding genuineness of the said compromise, however, as per report of the

Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur, none of the parties appeared before

him to get their statements recorded.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent—complainant submits that though a compromise had been arrived at between the parties on 21.10.2019, whereby they had decided to reside together but it did not work for any longer, as she has been once again abused by the petitioner and thrown out of the matrimonial home.

Faced with the above situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
