Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.053 dated 23.06.2018, under Section 306 read with Section 34 IPC (Sections 309 and 116 deleted later on), registered at Police Station, S.G.N. Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda.

On 19.11.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners were found innocent after investigation. However, the trial court has proceeded to take cognizance against the petitioners and others under Section 193 Cr.P.C. It is pointed out that the case is now fixed for 22nd November, 2019.

Let the petitioners appear before the trial court on the date fixed and upon their appearance, the Court shall admit them on interim regular bail.

Adjourned to 07.02.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance

of the order dated 19.11.2019, the petitioners submitted themselves before the Court on 25.11.2019, who have been released on interim regular bail upon furnishing the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Harpinder Kaur, does not dispute this fact that the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court on 25.11.2019 and furnished the bail bonds and surety bonds.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and petitioners are allowed to remain on the same bail bonds and surety bonds furnished by them before the trial Court on 25.11.2019.
