The present application has been filed for preponing the date of hearing of the main case and for placing on record the compromise-deed dated 14.08.2020 as Annexure A-1 with further prayer to withdraw the main appeal viz. FAO-M-2-2019.

Learned counsel for the respondent has not disputed the factum of compromise.

Keeping in view the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the applicant-appellant intends to withdraw the main appeal, hearing of the main case is preponed from 09.11.2020 to today itself for final disposal. The compromise-deed is also taken on record as Annexure A-1.

CM stands disposed of.

FAO-2-2020

The marriage between the parties was solemnised on 08.02.2011 as per Hindu rites and ceremonies. They lived together and cohabited with each other. Out of this wedlock, one daughter was born. Due to matrimonial dispute, both the parties have been residing separately since long time. A divorce petition was filed by the appellant-husband, which was dismissed by the Additional District Judge, Panchkula. Assailing the said judgment, the present appeal has been preferred.

During the pendency of the present appeal, both the parties have amicably resolved their disputes and arrived at a compromise deed dated 14.08.2020 (Annexure A-1), perusal of which reveals that the parties to the *lis* have decided that all the pending litigations between them would be withdrawn after the settled amount is received by the first party, i.e. wife-respondent.

Keeping in view of the totality of facts and circumstances as also the prayer made in CM-9121-CII-2020, the appellant-husband is permitted to withdraw the present appeal, in terms of the compromise (A-1). Accordingly, the present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.
