[1]. The petitioner has remained in detention since 19.11.2018.

[2]. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that out of the 27 challaned witnesses as many as 18 have already been examined, 3 given up and the matter is now fixed for evidence of the remaining 6 witnesses, who are all Police Officers or Official witnesses.

[3]. Ld. State counsel concurs with the submissions that all the private witnesses including the complainant and members of the deceased's family have not given any incriminating statement against the petitioner and have all been declared hostile.

[4]. In such circumstances, at this stage, the petitioner is permitted to be released on conditional bail till conclusion of the Trial Court. It shall stand cancelled if he is found guilty by the Ld. Trial Court.
