Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 302 dated 30.09.2019 registered under Sections 323, 506 and 34 IPC and Section 3 of The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 , at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Vide order dated 18.11.2019, interim bail was granted to the petitioner with direction to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 18.11.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajinder, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

At this stage, Mr. Sandeep Parkash Chahar, Advocate, has appeared and filed power of attorney on behalf of the complainant in Court today, which is taken on record. He states that FIR No. 303 dated 30.09.2019 has been got registered by co-accused Bijender only to cover the delay.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 18.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
