Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.379 dated 19.03.2019 under Section 174-A IPC, registered at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, Gurugram and complaint case No.16185 of 2016 under Sections 138/141 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

On 10.12.2019, following order was passed by this Court: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was never summoned in the proceedings under Sections 138/141 of N.I. Act. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court in the complaint case and he will also appear before the Investigating Officer in the FIR case.

List again on 29.01.2020.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today, in complaint case and he will be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds.

The petitioner is further directed to appear before the Investigating Officer for the purpose of joining the investigation, in FIR case and his arrest shall remain stayed subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court in complaint case and is released on interim bail and he has even appeared before the Investigating Officer in FIR case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Raj Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation in FIR No.379 and is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
