Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 92 dated 24.06.2019 registered under Section 379-B IPC at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has not committed any offence and has been falsely implicated in the case. There has no eye witness and the petitioner has not been named in the FIR and he has been in judicial custody since 07.07.2019. He further states that no *prima facie* case is made out against the petitioner. The investigation has been completed, challan has been submitted and charges have been framed. The trial would take long time to conclude.

Heard.

As per the allegations, the petitioner has snatched the gold ear-ring from the left ear of the complainant and has ran away from the spot.

Moreover, the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fazilka, while dismissing the bail application of the petitioner, vide judgment dated 09.09.2019 observed that “this is a case of snatching and such like offences are rampant in the ultrasonically fat evolving society and such offences pose gigantic threat to the society at large”.

In view of the above, no ground is made to allow the prayer of the petitioner.

Present petition is dismissed accordingly.
