1 This order shall dispose of above mentioned two petitions.
Since common questions of law and facts are involved therein, they are
being decided by this common order.

2 These petitions have been filed challenging certain
notifications/circulars dated 02.07.2019/15.05.2019. Primary reliance has
been made on a decision of the Gujarat High Court (Annexure P-8) which
had set aside the impugned notifications/circulars.

3 Today learned counsel for the revenue-respondents points out that the operation of the judgment of the Gujarat High Court on which reliance has been placed has been stayed by the Supreme Court by order dated 02.12.2019.

4 Counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to dispute this.

5 In the circumstances, these petitions stand disposed of as infructuous at this stage leaving the petitioner with liberty to pursue the remedy of appeal.

6 Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

7 Since the main cases have been disposed of as infructuous, the pending Applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
