Custody certificate dated 27.11.2019, by way of affidavit of Sh. Gurmukh Singh, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda, has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.141 dated 05.07.2016, registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda, under Sections 379-B, 148 and 149 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that compromise has been effected between the parties as they belong to the same village.

Learned counsel for the complainant does not dispute the

factum of compromise.

On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the prayer made in the present petition.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

As per the custody certificate, three other FIRS have been registered against the petitioner. Out of the aforesaid three FIRS, he has been acquitted in FIR No.08 dated 10.01.2017, under Sections 307, 336, 341, 427 and 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, and in the remaining two, he is on bail.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody since 16.09.2019. The trial of the case would take time to conclude. Moreover, co-accused have already been granted bail by the learned Sessions Judge, Bathinda. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
