Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.216 dated 24.08.2019 under Section 21 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sector-34, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for the last about 01 year and the case is still at the stage of recording the prosecution evidence. It is further submitted that as per allegations in the FIR, recovery of 40 grams of heroin was effected from the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has, however, opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that there are number of cases pending against the petitioner, therefore, mere custody of about one year is not sufficient and cannot be taken a ground to grant him bail.

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A perusal of the custody certificate dated 10.08.2020 filed in the Court today, shows that the petitioner is facing 09 other FIRs; two under NDPS Act and 07 FIRs under Sections 379/380 IPC. A perusal of the custody certificate further shows that the petitioner stands convicted in as many as 03 FIRs.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
