The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.22 dated 22.02.2019 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and 13 of the Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012 at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 25.11.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that the petitioner is ready to hand over a demand draft of Rs.2 lacs to the complainant in the Court subject to final outcome of the case.

Notice of motion for 18.12.2019.”

Thereafter, on 18.12.2019 and 02.03.2020, the petitioner was granted extension of time to deposit the aforesaid amount in compliance with order dated 25.11.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has submitted that the petitioner has not yet deposited the said amount.

Learned counsel for the petitioner could not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
