The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 133 dated 26.07.2018, registered under Sections 420 and 406 IPC at Police Station Bicchore, District Nuh (Mewat).

The operative part of the order dated 22.11.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of over an year in registering the FIR wherein it is alleged that co-accused, namely, Mohd. Basid Khutta @ Rahul had sold fake gold biscuits by enticing them at 50% discount. He also contends that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the supplementary statement that the petitioner was also present along with the co-accused at the time of occurrence....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 22.11.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the

Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Navneet Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
