The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.81 dated 03.10.2019, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 498-A, 34 of IPC added later on vide DDR No.27 dated 05.10.2019), registered at Police Station Bhadaur, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Hardev Singh, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and after investigation, it

has been found that cause of death was natural and as such, a cancellation report was filed in the matter, which has already been accepted on 06.01.2020 by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Barnala.

In view of the fact that a cancellation report has already been accepted in the matter, as such, no further orders are called for.
