Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to call the status of the complaint filed by the petitioner or further issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to register an FIR against respondents No.4 to 7 with further prayer to decide the complaint/representations dated 27.9.2018 and 23.2.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Ram Singh has submitted that an enquiry was conducted in which it was found that there was a civil dispute between the petitioner and the private respondents regarding sale and purchase of some goods during the course of their business. With regard to the said dispute a complaint under Section 138 Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 between the parties is also pending. After holding the said enquiry, it was recommended to file the said complaint as no offence was found to have been committed. It is further submitted by the learned State counsel that the enquiry report has been approved by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda on 1.2.2020.

In view of the same, no further action is called for and, therefore, the present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
