Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called

for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
To be heard along with CRM-M-38859-2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioners submitted themselves before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioners cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

On the other hand learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant opposed the prayer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Jaswinder Pal Singh does not dispute this fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation. Learned counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Pal Singh further states that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 21.11.2019 is made absolute.
