Petitioner-**Anil Kumar** has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.0039 dated 23.07.2019 registered under Section 379-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "the IPC") at Police Station GRP Sirsa (**Annexure P-1**) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom in view of the compromise dated 14.11.2019 (**Annexure P-2**) effected with respondent No.2-**Kajal Rani**.

The above said FIR was registered on the statement of respondent No.2/complainant-Kajal Rani regarding snatching of her purse containing her mobile phone, railway ticket from Sirsa to Hisar and Rs.590/- by the petitioner on 23.07.2019 at Railway Station, Sirsa. The petitioner was apprehended immediately after snatching and recovery was made from him and the articles recovered and the petitioner was identified by respondent No.2/complainant-Kajal Rani.

The petitioner has filed the present petition for quashing of the FIR on the grounds that now with the intervention of respectables, the matter has been amicably compromised between the parties and they have resolved their differences.

On realising that FIR involves offence of public character having social impact which is not liable to be quashed on the basis of compromise, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks dismissal of the petition as withdrawn.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
