Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.25 dated 10.03.2019 under Sections 342, 506(II) IPC and Section 4 of the POCSO Act, 2012(the offence under Section 376(3) IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Women Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Rekha, submits that as against total 20 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 19 witnesses have been examined and the case is now fixed for 03.03.2020 for the remaining evidence.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
