The instant petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to hand over the inquiry into FIR No.207 dated 06.10.2018, under Sections 15, 27, 27-A and 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Ludhiana, to respondent No.5 or to some other independent agency.
