From the perusal of the file it is apparent that employees of the petitioner had been exonerated on the departmental side vide enquiry dated 19.08.2005 conducted by Capt. Narinder Singh, IAS (Retd.) The same was also relied upon by the authorities while rejecting the claim of the petitioner.

Mr. Vikas, however, submits that the said enquiry report was dissented and punishment order was imposed on the employees-respondent Nos.1 and 2 vide order dated 30.06.2009. However, the same has not been placed on record.

In such circumstances, counsel does not press the writ petition and prays for liberty to file a fresh one while bringing complete facts on record including the fact whether the employee as such have challenged the order of punishment, as referred above.

Ordered accordingly.
