On 16.12.2019, following order was passed:-

“Contends that as per the allegations of the prosecution itself, there is no recovery from the petitioner, in this case, rather the contraband, i.e. tramadol tablets are stated to have been recovered from his brother, namely Ramesh Ram, who was arrested at the spot on 20.03.2019. Also contends that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner, but police is unnecessarily harassing him.

Learned State counsel wishes to verify the pendency of any other case against the petitioner as well as his complicity in the present case.

On his request, adjourned to 20.02.2020.

*In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail, **till the next date of hearing**, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of above said order, petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 16.12.2019, is made absolute.
