This is the second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 57, dated 28.03.2017, under Sections 376-D, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station C-Division, Amritsar.

It has been brought to the notice of this Court that first petition i.e. CRM-M-26082-2017 for grant of Anticipatory Bail was dismissed on merits vide order dated 18.07.2018 of this Court.

The second petition for grant of anticipatory bail would be maintainable only in case of changed circumstances. However, learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to show any change in the circumstances after dismissal of the first anticipatory bail on 18.07.2018.

In view of this, no ground for grant concession of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
