The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.176 dated 04.10.2019, registered under Sections 457, 380, 511, 447, 427, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') at Police Station Sadar Sangrur.

2. Heard.

3. On 26.11.2019, the following order was passed:-

*“Contends that both the petitioners suffered injuries and reference, in this regard, is made to Annexures P-3 and P-4.*

*Notice of motion returnable on 14.01.2020.*

*In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit them to interim bail, **till the next date of hearing**, on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his*

*satisfaction. The petitioners are also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”*

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition stands allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 26.11.2019, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer, concerned.
