Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.158 dated 28.07.2016 under Sections 302, 201, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in custody since 30.07.2016. She further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel submits that the charges against the accused persons were framed on 18.01.2019 and 3 out of 13 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

I have considered the rival submissions.

The petitioner is behind the bars for the last more than three years and five months and there is no other case pending against him. The

trial of the case will take some time and further detention of the petitioner

will not serve any useful purpose.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
