HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 69 dated 08.05.2019 registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC (Act No. 45 of 1860) at Police Station City-1, Mansa, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn the attention of this Court towards the FIR, in which complainant-Krishan Singh, who is brother of deceased-Gogi Singh, has stated that his sister-in-law had illicit relationship with one Jassi Singh (Ghora) son of late Jaswant Singh (petitioner) from last about 3 years. He argued that neither there is any complaint to any authority nor to Panchayat regarding the aforesaid relationship and the petitioner has been confined for the last more than 7 months. He further states that trial would take time in its conclusion.

On the instructions from ASI Teja Singh, learned State counsel states that charges have been framed.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties. The petitioner is in custody for the last more than 7 months and charges has been framed, the trial will take time to conclude and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
