This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
for grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 27 dated
26.9.2019 registered under Sections 7-A of the Prevention of
Corruption Act at Police Station Vigilance Bureau Range,
Ferozepur.

Petitioner was caught by the vigilance team with an

amount of Rs.10,000/- Allegations against the petitioner are that he also received an amount of Rs.20,000/- earlier for removing the name of the complainant from the list of those persons, who used to consume and sell intoxicants. It is in that context, a trap was laid and the petitioner was caught red handed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Amardeep Singh, states that the application for taking the voice sample of the petitioner has been moved in order to analyse the whatsapp call recorded in some other mobile phone.

It is not in dispute that the challan has been presented on 21.11.2019. Even charges have been framed. The next date fixed is 7.2.2020. Out of total 18 prosecution witnesses, no prosecution witness has been examined so far. Petitioner is in custody since 26.9.2019. The trial of the case may take some time in its culmination.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, it would be just and appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

In view of above, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial

Court.
