Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.114 dated 12.07.2019 registered under Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 and Section 506 of IPC at Police Station Women NIT, Faridabad, District Faridabad.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he has committed rape upon a girl, about 15 years of age, and made her pregnant, and she had delivered a baby on 19.11.2019. The argument of counsel for the petitioner that there is no specific date and time as regard the commission of offence and the petitioner is ready to undergo DNA test, cannot be accepted at the stage when the petitioner has approached this Court for anticipatory bail. At this stage, the allegations made by the prosecutrix are to be believed.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
