JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J.

The present petition has been filed seeking the concession of anticipatory bail in CIS No.N.I. Act/13355/2017 dated 22.09.2017, under Section 138 read with Section 142 of the Negotialbe Instruments Act, 1881.

On 17.01.2018, the petitioner was granted bail by the Court of JMIC, Gurugram and the case was fixed for 18.01.2018 and thereafter, on six consecutive dates exemption applications were filed and the petitioner did not appear before the Court. The learned JMIC, Gurugram has passed an order dated 23.04.2019 (Annexure P-2) by observing that the exemption applications have been dismissed and the bail of the accused was cancelled.

The reasoning given by the petitioner that on 23.04.2019, he could not attend the Court on account of the marriage of the daughter of his sister, would not hold good on account of the fact that on earlier six dates, he did not appear before the Court. In view of the continued absence of the petitioner from the Court proceedings, no interference is called for by this Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is hereby dismissed.

However, this is not to be treated as expression of any opinion or observations regarding the merits of the case.
