In compliance of order dated 14.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced receipts of `20,000/-. The same are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.0023 dated 09.02.2018, registered under Sections 323, 458, 380, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 325, 459 added lateron and 365 IPC deleted), at Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexures P1 and P2) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-4) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 14.01.2020 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 05.02.2020 to get their

statements recorded.

Learned Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.252 dated 05.02.2020, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Muktsar, vide Endst. No.939 dated 06.02.2020.

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, FIR No.0023 dated 09.02.2018, registered under Sections 323, 458, 380, 427, 506, 48, 149 IPC (Sections 325, 459 added lateron and 365 IPC deleted), at Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexures P1 and P2) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Registry shall verify the deposit of costs by the petitioners with the quarters concerned.
