Prayer in the present petition is for grant of pre-arrest bail to petitioners in case F.I.R. No.183 dated 07.09.2019 under Sections 323 and 506 IPC read with Section 34 IPC (Section 307 was added later on), registered at Police Station Baroda, District Sonapat.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jitender, submits that in compliance of order dated 27.11.2019, petitioners have already joined investigation and they are not required for further investigation.

At this juncture, Mr. Sandeep Kumar Rana, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2/Sunil (complainant). He has filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record. He submits that the matter has already been compromised between the complainant and petitioners and to

this effect, duly sworn affidavit of complainant (Sunil) has already been placed on record as Annexure P-4. Sunil (complainant), who is present in person has also given concurrence to this effect.

In view of above, order dated 27.11.2019 granting interim bail to petitioners, is made absolute. Petitioners shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
