LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

This application has been filed seeking transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'Act') filed by the respondent at Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 02.11.2020. Terms and conditions of the settlement have been reduced into writing and are attached as Annexure A-1 with CM No. 10768-CII of 2020. It is further submitted that petition under Section 9 of the Act, has since been withdrawn by the respondent in terms of the settlement arrived at between the parties, therefore the present petition has become infructuous and the petition seeks to withdraw the same.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances and at request of learned counsel for the applicant, hearing of the transfer application is preponed from 10.02.2021 for today itself.

Keeping in view of the above, CM No. 10768-CII of 2020 is allowed and T.A No. 1078 of 2019 is dismissed as withdrawn.
