Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dinesh Kumar submits that petitioner Sunil @ Anil has been declared proclaimed offender in this case and in the light of the same, the present petition by proclaimed offender, prima facie, is not tenable.

At this stage, faced with the likely consequences, counsel for the petitioner has made a statement withdrawing the present petition, however, reserving the rights of the petitioner to first challenge the order declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender and, thereafter, approach this Court afresh on same very grounds.
