Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.93 dated 16.09.2019 under Sections 21 and 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Special Task Force, District STF Wing, SAS, Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is for 5 grams of heroin, which is small quantity. The petitioner is in custody since 16.09.2019. He further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel submits that the challan in this case has been presented on 14.11.2019 and charges were framed on 30.11.2019.

I have considered the rival submissions.

The petitioner is behind the bars for the last more than four months and there is no other case pending against him. The trial of the case will take some time and further detention of the petitioner will not serve

any useful purpose.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
