Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer is made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising out of FIR No. 32 dated 28.02.2018 under Section 18,21, 23 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that alleged recovery of 2.75 kg. of Heroin and 290 gram of Opium was not effected from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Allegation against the petitioner that 500 gram of Heroin recovered from his house, is false. He has falsely been implicated. Petitioner is in custody since 2018. Conclusion of the trial may take sufficient long time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in jail anymore.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposed the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Considering the huge quantity of recovery of Heroin and
Opium from the petitioner, he does not deserve any concession of bail.

Dismissed.
