This order of mine shall dispose of CRM-M-51008-2019, filed
by petitioner-Amjad and CRM-M-51022-2019, filed by petitioner-Parvej,

**CRM-M-51008-2019 and
CRM-M-51022-2019**

under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.154 dated 10.06.2019, registered at Police Station Pinangwan, District Nuh, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 341, 506 and 307 IPC.

Vide orders dated 02.12.2019, the petitioners were directed to join the investigation and if they were sought to be arrested, they would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the orders dated 02.12.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Bachhu Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation; that recovery has already been effected from them and that they are not required for any further investigation.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed and the orders dated 02.12.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
