Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.51 dated 26.07.2019 under Sections 420, 384, 385, 386 and 387 of IPC registered at Police Station Talwandi Chaudrian, District Kapurthala.

On 03.02.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sarabjeet Singh states that the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

In view of the facts and circumstances of this case, one more opportunity is granted to the petitioner to join the investigation on 06.02.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his appearance before the Investigating Officer, he

shall be enlarged on *ad interim* bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C
Adjourned to 06.03.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 03.02.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation.

This fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, and states that the petitioner is not required for any further investigation of the case.

In view of the above, order dated 03.02.2020 is made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
