Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.535 dated 02.11.2019, registered at Police Station Sector 14, Gurugram, under Sections 323, 506 and 34 IPC and Sections 325 and 307 IPC (added later on).

On 02.12.2019, this Court passed the following order:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the present FIR No. 535 dated 02.11.2019 registered under Sections 323, 506 and 34 of IPC and Sections 325 and 307 of IPC added later on, at Police Station Sector-14, Gurugram, the role attributed to the petitioner-Jatin is that he has given kick blows with his legs and slapped the complainant. Moreover, the alleged incident is of 30.10.2019 but the FIR was registered on 02.11.2019.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he will be

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released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 02.12.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vinod Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 02.12.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
