[1]. This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, in case FIR No.66 dated 17.06.2019, under Sections 379-B(2) & 34 of the IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Mohkampura, District Amritsar.

[4]. Investigation is already completed and challan submitted. The only incriminating circumstance transpiring against the petitioner is that a part of the stolen money amounting to ₹1 lac was recovered from the petitioner. He was neither named in the FIR nor there is any material to show his direct involvement in the alleged offence under Section 379-B(2) of the IPC or of the Arms Act.

[5]. Considering the detention undergone by the petitioner which is in excess of six months at this stage, he is ordered to be released on regular

bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld.
