This is an application under Section 151 of CPC for preponement of hearing of the main case.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that he has no objection if the present application is allowed.

In view of the above, the present application is allowed and the main petition is preponed from 16.12.2020 to today itself and taken up on board for hearing.

CWP No.34933 of 2019

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 23.10.2019 (Annexure P-8).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is a Pump Operator and claiming to the promotion to the post of Charge-Man. He further states that the petitioner is about to retire on 28.02.2021. The petitioner had served a legal notice dated 23.10.2019 (Annexure P-8) upon respondents No.4 to 6 but till date no action has been taken by the department. He further states that he would be satisfied, if legal notice dated 23.10.2019 (Annexure P-8 ) is decided by respondent No.3, within stipulated time.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 (The Engineer-in-Chief, Haryana Shaheri Vikas Pradhikaran, Panchkula) to decide the legal notice dated 23.10.2019 (Annexure P- 8) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law.
