The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.98 dated 03.10.2019 under Sections 420/34 IPC and Section 61 of Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Lambran, Jalandhar.

The operative part of the order dated 13.12.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, 120 bottles of whiskey were recovered from the vehicle and coaccused Jasvir Singh was apprehended at the spot. It is further submitted that the petitioner was later on nominated in the FIR on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused and is not involved in any other case.

Notice of motion for 06.02.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 13.12.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC

Shingara Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 13.12.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
