Reply (in CRWP No.1328 of 2019) of Superintendent Jail, District Jail, Kaithal along with documents appended thereto, filed on behalf of the Respondents No.1 to 6, today in Court; Be kept on record.

2. The Petitioners, in these cases had applied for release on parole to do agriculture operation, after their conviction. Their Representation were, however, rejected by the Commissioner, Karnal Division, Karnal *inter*

alia on the ground that none of them had completed the minimum required period of one year Post Conviction nor had earned any first annual good conduct remission.

3. It is not the case of any of the Petitioner that the requisite period had already been covered when the Representation was submitted/rejected.

4. Ld. Counsel for the Petitioners nevertheless submits that by now the said required period has already been completed and the Petitioners, therefore, are entitled to be released on parole.

5. Be that as it may, when the impugned order of the Commissioner, Karnal Division, Karnal suffers from no infirmity, there is no scope for this Court to direct release of the Petitioners on its own at this stage.

6. The matter is, therefore, disposed off after rejecting the present Petitions but with a liberty to the Petitioners to submit their fresh Representations seeking release on parole, which will be decided by the Competent Authorities preferably within two months thereafter.
