Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.773 dated 02.12.2015, registered at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal, under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B IPC.

On 10.12.2019, this Court passed the following order:

“This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0773 dated 02.12.2015, under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on the similar facts, another FIR No.08 dated 05.02.2016, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC was registered at Police Station EOW Cell, South East, New Delhi, in which, petitioner has been granted regular bail and on the same application, the present FIR has been lodged. Counsel for

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the petitioner further states that while considering these arguments, the petitioner has been granted interim bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-50712-2019, which is fixed for 18.12.2019.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 10.12.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Satya Narayan, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 10.12.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
