This appeal has been filed against an order dated 30.10.2019 passed by the learned Single Judge disposing of the writ petition being CWP-16469-1999 filed by the petitioner (appellant herein) granting all the retiral benefits except pension to him.

From a perusal of the order passed by the learned Single Judge, it is evident that the learned Single Judge taking into consideration the provisions of Regulation 22 of the Punjab National Bank (Employees') Pension Regulations, 1995 has held that the appellant is not entitled to pensionary benefits as he has resigned from service. The fact of resignation and the provisions of the Regulations are undisputed.

In the circumstances, we do not find any reason to interfere with the order passed by the learned Single Judge, more so, as the learned Single Judge has already granted adequate relief to the appellant as contained in paragraphs 11 and 12 of the impugned order.

The appeal filed by the appellant being meritless is accordingly dismissed.
