This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.464 dated 06.9.2019, under Sections 379 and 188 IPC, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 10.1.2019 whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“Adjourned to 10.02.2020.

Meanwhile the petitioner is directed to join

investigation. In the event of his arrest, he be released on interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall continue to join the investigation as and when required by the investigating agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by HC Harvender Singh does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned counsel on instructions from HC Harvender Singh further states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 10.1.2019 is made absolute.
