Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Malkiat Singh has submitted that on receiving a complaints on 10.6.2019, 19.9.2019, 4.1.2020 and 21.1.2020, the petitioners were given notices for joining the enquiry and record their statements but the petitioners have not turned up to give their statements in support of the allegations made and, therefore, the police officials are unable to conduct an enquiry and could not come to a conclusion whether there is any threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has shown the notices wherein the petitioners after receiving the notices themselves requested that they will appear on 19.6.2019 but they failed to do so.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and the same stands disposed of as such.
